



PREAMBLE

Whereas, VC and MC have many areas of common interest in Arts subject, considerable advantage may be gained from their pursuit of academic excellence on a collaborative basis in the fields of academics, pedagogy and research.

- vii) Conducting study tours and joint consultancy work







The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is effective as of 02/05/2021 (Effective date) to establish an affiliation by and between

Maheshtala College, an undergraduate degree college with its office at Budge Budge Trunk Road, P.O.Chandannagar, Kolkata-141, P.S.Maheshtala, District South 24 – Parganas, established in 1971, hereinafter referred to as MC and represented by its Principal, referred to as FIRST PART.

AND

Prasanta Chandra Mahalanobis Mahavidyalaya, Kolkata, one of the premiere academic institutes in the State of West Bengal (West Bengal State University) established in the year 1965. It is located at 111/3 B.T.Road, BonHooghly, Kolkata—700108 West Bengal. This College, hereinafter referred to as PCMM and represented by its Principal, referred to as SECOND PART, for the of exchange of students, staff and faculty.

The aforesaid institutions are hereinafter referred to individually/collectively as college/colleges.

PREAMBLE

Whereas, MC and PCMM have many areas of common interest in Arts subject, considerable advantage may be gained from their pursuit of academic excellence on a collaborative basis in the fields of academics, pedagogy and research.
